

Main Toolbar

(Teacher Window)

The Main toolbar, located below the Menu Bar, contains buttons for the most frequently used Discourse commands. You can toggle the display of the Main toolbar by clicking [View > Main Toolbar](#).



Button	Name	Description
	Previous Frame	Displays the previous frame.
	Go to Frame/Create Frames	Shows the number of the current frame. Displays the number of the frame you have entered. If you enter a frame number greater than the number of existing frames, new frames are created.
	Next Frame	Displays the next frame.
	Publish Frame	While in Social Mode, sends the current frame's content to the class.
	Wait/Resume	Freezes students' displays so that they cannot view or enter responses to questions.
	Class Log on	Allows students to log on and off.
	Social mode	Enables Social Mode, allowing you to control the pace of the lesson.
	Self-Paced mode	Enables Self-Paced mode, allowing students to work at their own pace.
	Frame Responses	(Default) Shows all students' responses for the current frame.
	Frame Pie Chart	Displays student responses as a pie chart, dividing responses into different colored wedges for correct answers, incorrect answers, and no response from students.
	Class Display Preview	Opens the Class Display Preview window and allows you to prepare and preview (on your screen) what will appear on students' screens.
	Clear Class Display	Removes everything that is on the Class Display.
	Help	Displays this online help.
